



ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- **Presentation types:** Oral presentation only, Oral or Poster presentation, or Poster presentation only
- Abstracts must be submitted **online via the IUBMB/FASBMB/SASBMB Congress 2027 Abstract Submission Portal**. Submissions sent by email will not be accepted.
- All abstracts must be written in **English**.
- It is the author's responsibility to ensure accuracy. Any errors in spelling, grammar, or scientific content will be published exactly as submitted.
- Abstracts should be **original, topical, and current**, and should preferably not have been previously published or presented.
- Authors may submit a maximum of two abstracts as the presenting author for consideration. Co-authorship on additional abstract submissions will be permitted.
- Submission of an abstract implies the author's consent to its inclusion in congress-related publications.
- The Scientific Programme Committee reserves the right to determine the final presentation format.

Abstract Submission Topics

Abstracts should align with one or more of the following themes:

1. Bioinformatics, Computational Biology and Systems Biology
2. Structural Biology and Biophysics (supported by IUPAB)
3. Infectious and Parasitic Diseases
4. Development, Stem Cells and Cancer
5. Chromosomal dynamics, Gene Regulation and Expression
6. Molecular Basis of Disease
7. Prevention, Management and Treatment of Disease and Infection
8. Bioprospecting: Natural Products and Phytomedicine
9. Biotechnology and Synthetic Biology in the circular bioeconomy
10. Chemical Biology & Drug Discovery
11. Education Paradigm Shifts: Personalised Learning & Technology Integration

Abstract Structure & Formatting

Original Research Abstracts



Original research abstracts should preferably not have been previously accepted for publication or presented at another congress.

Abstracts must be structured as follows:

- **Background**
Brief background to the research topic, clearly identifying the problem and the aim of the study.
- **Methods**
A concise description of the study design, methods, and techniques used.
- **Results**
Clear description of results.
- **Conclusions**
Interpretation of findings, significance of results, and implications for clinical practice or future research.

Word Limits

- **Abstract Title:** Maximum 30 words
- **Abstract body:** Maximum 250 words

Review and Selection

Abstract Review

All submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the **IUBMB/FASBMB/SASBMB Congress 2027 Scientific Programme Committee**. Abstracts will be evaluated based on scientific merit, relevance to the congress themes, clarity, and originality.

Notification of acceptance or rejection

- All submitting authors will be informed in writing of the outcome of their abstract submission.
- Only the submitting author will receive official correspondence and is responsible for informing co-authors.
- Submitting author must confirm their attendance and presentation upon abstract acceptance

Registration

- The invitation to submit an abstract does not constitute an offer to pay travel, accommodation or registration costs associated with the Congress.



- If accepted, at least one of the listed authors must be registered and be in attendance to present your work.
- All presenting authors need to register by 31 March 2027 to confirm inclusion of your submission in the Programme.
